## Our Challenge:

Since 1869, our **church** has made room for God's ministry in Norwalk. In **1872**, we built our first building in this exact location. 100 years later, we completed the building we are now in, and added on to it in 1991. Through the generosity of 150 years of faithful giving, we have a debt-free facility in the heart of **Norwalk**. That is something to celebrate!

Our challenge now is to update our facility for ministry today. **Already**, we have ministry happening that is hampered by limitations to flexibility and **accessibility**. These renovations will **MAKE ROOM FOR ALL** that **God** is already doing and will do through our ministry.

Building on the example set by those who entrusted this facility to us, we want to ensure that our facility will be able to meet the needs of **ministry** for many years to come without saddling us with debt.

To do this, it will take **generous** gifts over the next **three** years (above and beyond your normal offerings to the church). We believe it is **possible!**

## Our Goal:

- Complete Phases 1 and 2 by raising **\$325,000** over three years (June 2018 - June 2021) through pledges and one-time gifts.
- Begin **design** work on each phase when funding reaches 60%.
- Begin **construction** on each phase when funding reaches 80% (pending congregation's final approval of building contract).

## Your Part:

- **First, pray** for the **success** of this campaign, for **guidance** as you consider your commitment, and for God to continue to **bless** the ministry of NCC.
- **Second, ask** our campaign team, church board, or pastors if you have any **questions**.

- **Fourth, honor** your pledge by **giving** above and **beyond** your regular offerings from June 1, 2018 – May 31, 2021.

# The Plan:

\*The following costs are estimates & may change after design phase.

## PHASE 1 - \$152,000

- Install **elevator** allowing full accessibility to lower level.
- Remodel **Sanctuary and Chancel** for flexibility, accessibility, and improved lighting.

## PHASE 2 - \$148,000

- Create handicap accessible **restrooms**.
- Expand **Narthex** area, adding movable panels in fellowship hall.
- Transform **offices** into a suite.
- Add new **stairway** inside front entry.

## PHASE 3 - \$221,000

- Focus of a future campaign.
- Expand **Fellowship Hall**.

## 2018 Capital Campaign Goal
